Job Purpose Statement:

Applications are invited for a Research Associate in Shi'i Studies at the International Centre of Advanced Islamic Research (ICAIR), London. The postholder will be expected to engage in high quality research in the field of Islamic Studies, with a focus on Twelver Shi'ism. The postholder will also be expected to actively participate in the work of ICAIR, including its journal, publications, courses, and events.

Role Responsibilities:

Job Purpose:

The postholder will be expected to contribute to the intellectual life of ICAIR and the wider field of Islamic studies. Duties will include the following: - Produce research of the highest quality and make important contributions to the field - Advance the field of research through publications, creative work, and other forms of work including the organization of relevant events both online and in person - Contribute to the production of the journal, publications, seminars, conferences and other events at ICAIR. - Demonstrate flexibility and adaptability in undertaking diverse responsibilities due to the lean team structure. - Aid in the achievement of ICAIR's Key Performance Indicators (KPIs) through research, publications, and active participation in the institute's projects.

Main Duties and Responsibilities:

- Deliver interdisciplinary and impactful research that advances Shi'i studies nationally and internationally, contributing to the Institute's mission of being a leading institution of academic excellence in the field.
- Publish original research of excellent quality targeted at specialist and general readership in a manner appropriate to the research field and academic discipline and relevant to the research and scholarship mission of the Institute.
- Engage in translation projects, translating pivotal texts or research from Arabic and
 Persian to English to bolster ICAIR's repository and outreach.
- Assist or lead in converting academic research, including potential PhD theses, into comprehensive publications like books for ICAIR's series.
- Engage with the research community at an appropriate level through conferences,
 committees, advisory and editorial bodies, and research reviews.
- Participate actively in outreach programs, podcasts, and other public engagements to promote ICAIR's research findings and contributions.

- Higher education teaching accreditation at least on the level of Associate Fellow or Fellow of HEA level (A/C).

- Excellent command of English and ability to produce high-quality research and writing in English (A/I/P)
- Excellent command of Arabic and, preferably also Persian (A/C)
- Good working knowledge of at least one more language of relevance to the field as well as one more European language (A/C)
- Clear and ambitious research plan for the future (A/I/P).
- Thorough understanding of traditional seminary (Hawza) studies is highly advantageous (A/I).

- Ability to communicate new and complex ideas and information in an effective and analytical manner, both verbally and in writing (A/I/P)
